

The RVACG shall provide equipment needed to run the public areas of the gardens including a riding lawn mower, and a push mower.

~~The RVACG shall provide a minimum of one riding lawn mower, 1 push mower for mowing.~~

For Gardener use, the RACG shall provide a minimum of 1 tiller for tilling plots, wagons, wheelbarrow and garden tools.

~~The RVACG shall provide wagons and wheelbarrows for gardener use.~~

~~The RVACG shall provide a small number of trowels, shovels, garden rakes, hoes, etc for gardeners to use.~~

The RVACG shall provide a small number of stakes of various sizes to use as supports. Returning Gardeners should plan on providing stakes, tomato supports, and trellising equipment as needed for their crops.

The RVACG shall help new gardeners by providing stakes and trellising equipment if they are unable to provide them.

The RVACG shall provide stakes or supports for plants in the food pantry and the public areas as needed.

Gardeners may store their equipment in their plots if so desired.

None of the gardening equipment or tools shall be taken from the Gardens for personal use.

The RVACG shall provide a hose for each irrigation post with one water nozzle. ~~Returning~~ Gardeners shall may provide their own hoses, sprinklers, nozzles, wands, or watering cans that may be kept in their plots.

An area for storage of communal property shall be established.
