

## Food Pantry Plots Policy

One of the purposes of the River Valley Area Community Gardens is to help relieve food scarcity and inequity in our local communities.

The RVACG Board shall dedicate plots annually to grow food for the Community Food Pantry of Spring Green.

A task team shall be established to help prepare plots, plant, mulch, tend and harvest these plots.

The RVACG shall provide a food kiosk on the Gardens site for the purpose of the distribution of excess produce from food pantry plots or from individual gardeners plots. The produce will be free. A donation box may be provided for those who wish to contribute.

The RVACG shall provide food to shut-ins unable to garden upon request.

The RVACG shall provide produce to local assisted living facilities and care institutions when available.
