

The River Valley Area Community Gardens has a variety of tasks that need to be completed during the growing season and behind the scenes tasks throughout the calendar year. There are a variety of tasks for age and ability levels.

The River Valley Area Community Gardens shall require all gardening families to commit to providing a minimum of 12 hours of volunteer work each gardening season. This is equivalent to 2 hours per month for the growing season of May through October.

The hours may be any combination of work including on-site garden maintenance on scheduled work days, serving on a task committee, working a fundraiser event, serving on the RVACG Board, helping with the Busy Bees program, mentoring Junior Gardeners or new Gardeners, helping with the Food Pantry plots, tending common areas like flower beds or fruit patches., tending the garden of someone who is on vacation, ill or other reason in which they are having difficulty watering or weeding on regular basis, etc..

Work hours may be completed at scheduled events or on the gardeners own time. It may be as simple as 30 minutes or less at a time.

The RVACG Board shall set up task forces / committees to coordinate the work.

The task forces include but are not limited to Grounds / Equipment / Irrigation ; Flowers / Perennials / Fruit; Food Pantry; Administration / Finance / Fundraising;
